

Pool Season 2011.... What do I need to do?

Situation  **Solution**  **Cost**

1	I have passes for everyone in my family from last year.	You need to do nothing. Your passes are good and will work at the 3 pools unless you are delinquent on dues or have had privileges suspended.	\$0
2	I have passes for some members, but also have children over age 2 by 7/14/2011	You will need to have passes made, but between ages 2 and 8 children's passes do not have pictures. Please email the address below or call the Association Office.	\$1 per child's pass age 5 by 7/14/2011 and younger if picked up at Windmill Office. Cost per pass if mailed to your home \$2 per pass. Children 6 by 7/14/2011 \$5 per pass.
3	I am new to Ashburn Farm Association, or have never had a pool membership.	You will need to come in to get passes made for everyone in your household. Only those age 9 by 7/14/2011 need pictures.	\$5 per pass needed regardless of age.
4	I have lost my passes.	You will need new passes but they can be reprinted and picked up or mailed. Please email.	\$5 per lost pass. Please see line 2 "Cost" column for pricing for children who did not need passes last year.
5	I have a new nanny.	The nanny will have to come in to get a pool pass.	\$5
6	I have a new person living in my house.	Anyone over 18 must prove residency to obtain a pool pass. State issue ID is preferred.	\$5 per pass

Every household in Ashburn Farm will receive 4 free guest passes and those are electronically added to each account. These free passes are per address, not per resident. They will be available for use at any of the 3 pools, beginning opening day. They do expire at the end of the 2011 season. They are non-transferable. Guest policies have not changed.
