



Ashburn Farm Pool Rules

Patrons must comply with all lifeguard instructions

- No glass containers or breakable objects
- No professional balls, pool appropriate Nerf equivalent only
- No food or drink except in designated areas
- No profane language
- No play equipment or wheeled vehicles, except wheelchairs and strollers
- No pets
- No alcohol or drugs
- No smoking
- No chewing gum
- No running, pushing, dunking, wrestling or rough play
- No general swimming in diving area
- No water toys or other equipment unless authorized by pool manager
- No diving in shallow area
- No tape players, CD players or radios unless accompanied by personal headphones. iPod or MP3 players are allowed but owners assume any and all responsibility for any damages that may occur to their property.
- No flotation devices except water wings, U.S.C.G. approved life vests, U.S.C.G. approved swimwear flotation devices, and noodles on specified “noodle nights”. During low attendance times, noodles may be used at the lifeguards discretion.
- No DISPOSABLE DIAPERS. Children not yet toilet trained must wear plastic pants or swim diapers under their bathing suits
- Children 11 and younger must be accompanied and supervised by an adult or care provider at least 14 years old
- Pool members are responsible for the conduct of their guests
- Children under 12 years must pass the Swim Test to use the diving boards and slide and must wear a wristband. The Swim Test must be taken each year.
- Parents are responsible for the safety and conduct of all children in their care
- Pool membership may be suspended or revoked for members or their guests failing to comply with the pool rules.
- All members and guests must shower before entering the pools.

For your information:

- ◆ **Members and their guests use the pools at their own risk**
- ◆ **No lifeguards are on duty at the wading pools.**
